

# Court 4 Marbella Denucia

Denuncia of the Spanish Justice System and request for a Public Enquiry.

## **Without Prejudice:**

I wish to bring criminal charges against Court Number 4 Marbella and the judge Dona Blanca Ester Diaz and her husband who at the time of his crime was head of the Interpol international crimes unit in Marbella, Inspector Jimenez Lomas, they are criminals and have ruined my life with their corruption and criminal acts along with negligence and dereliction of duty.

I also wish to bring charges against all the people involved in my extradition in Spain, from the UK, the court staff and justice system people who have been involved in recent times including any police officers and law enforcement agencies. Including but not limited to all the Fiscals involved in the case, all the judges involved in the case, and any other persons who handled paperwork relating to the case and extradition from the justice department.

I intend to sue for damages Without Prejudice for over two Billion UK Pounds all parties involved. I will be filing several criminal and civil cases and making several Denucias in Spain and the UK:

## **Criminal & Civil Lawsuits To Be Filed:**

1/ Criminal and Civil actions in Spain against the Spanish Government, Justice System, and individuals named in the denuncias. Charges to include conspiracy to pervert the course of justice, attempted murder, reckless endangerment to my family and my life, victimisation and persecution, fraudulent court documents, telecommunications act charges, dereliction of duty.

2/ Relating to Illegal Extradition and False Imprisonment:

Criminal and Civil actions against the Spanish and UK Governments, Justice System, and individuals named in the denuncias. Charges to include conspiracy to pervert the course of justice, reckless endangerment to my family and my life, victimisation and persecution.

3/ Relating to the Theft of IPR by MI5, MI6 and the Free Masons:

Criminal and Civil actions in London against the Spanish and UK Governments, Justice System, and individuals named in the denuncias. Charges to include Theft of IPR, conspiracy to pervert the course of justice, attempted murder, reckless endangerment to my family and my life, victimisation and persecution, fraudulent court documents, telecommunications act charges, dereliction of duty, Abuse of power.

4/ Relating to European Human Rights Case Strasbourg:

This case is relating to the overall justice systemic failures, false imprisonment and the time taken to come to a resolution. With a side issue of the use of microwave technology, voice to skull technology and RFID implants.

**I will be calling for a public enquiry and holding a press conference in Madrid.**

I have issued a denuncia with the Poder Judicial here in Spain over this matter, and have sent them all the information on the documents attached, to get a full background to the case and understand what is going on it is necessary to read all the information on the enclosed document Called: **Spanish Case**

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## The Case of Miscarriage of Justice resulting in my false imprisonment:

### Additional information sent to the Poder judicial in Spain:

On the 13/02/1992, i received a letter from the Under secretary of State for the UK saying that they had been in contact with the Marbella court and the case was about to go to the prosecutor, here is the letter that was sent to me:

That is a very basic outline of the complex judicial procedures to which Mr Owens is subject under Spanish law, but which may now be approaching their climax. The Court in Malaga has recently told our Consulate that it is about to send the case file to the Public Prosecutor. It therefore looks as though Mr Owens may soon know whether or when and on what charges he is to stand trial. Should the case be dismissed it would be open to him to apply through his lawyer for damages.

I do hope this explanation of Gary Owen's position will help relieve his mother's anxiety about him. Please reassure Mrs Owens that our Consulate in Malaga will continue to monitor developments, visit her son periodically, and give him whatever consular assistance they properly and reasonably can.

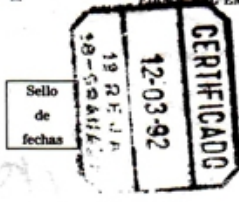

Sr. Juez:

Llevo en prisión cerca de un año y me gustaría saber por qué. Me ha sido imposible conseguir el suficiente dinero para pagar a un abogado que me represente, lo que significa que no tengo muchas posibilidades de someterme a un juicio justo ya que los abogados de oficio españoles no trabajan lo suficiente, o al menos en mi caso y en los de mis amigos. Tengo pruebas que ayudarían a demostrar mi inocencia, sin embargo, cada vez que me dirijo a alguien no obtengo ninguna respuesta.

Tengo derecho a una defensa, sin embargo, "su" llamado "sistema judicial" me niega este derecho.

Me gustaría saber en qué situación se encuentra mi caso y quién será mi abogado para poder contactar con él/ella. No quiero que me represente ninguno de los abogados que me han sido asignados anteriormente, ya que éstos no han hecho nada.

Esta es la cuarta carta que envío y aún no he obtenido respuesta alguna. Envío copias de ella a tres miembros del Parlamento Británico, dos miembros del Parlamento Europeo y al Subsecretario de Estado Británico, del mismo modo que a varios periodistas que se interesan por mi caso y que están muy sorprendidos del hecho de que me encuentre en prisión desde hace un año sin tener un sólo trozo de papel que explique el por qué.

Decir que siento un gran rechazo hacia su país, sería una afirmación demasiado dura, su sistema judicial es increíble. Su país necesita mucho más que una reforma, necesita despojarse de la vieja imagen Franquista y despertar a una Europa moderna en la que sí hay justicia, pero eso es sólo una opinión personal.

Por ahora, sería suficiente con decirme qué ocurre con mi caso y quién es mi abogado.

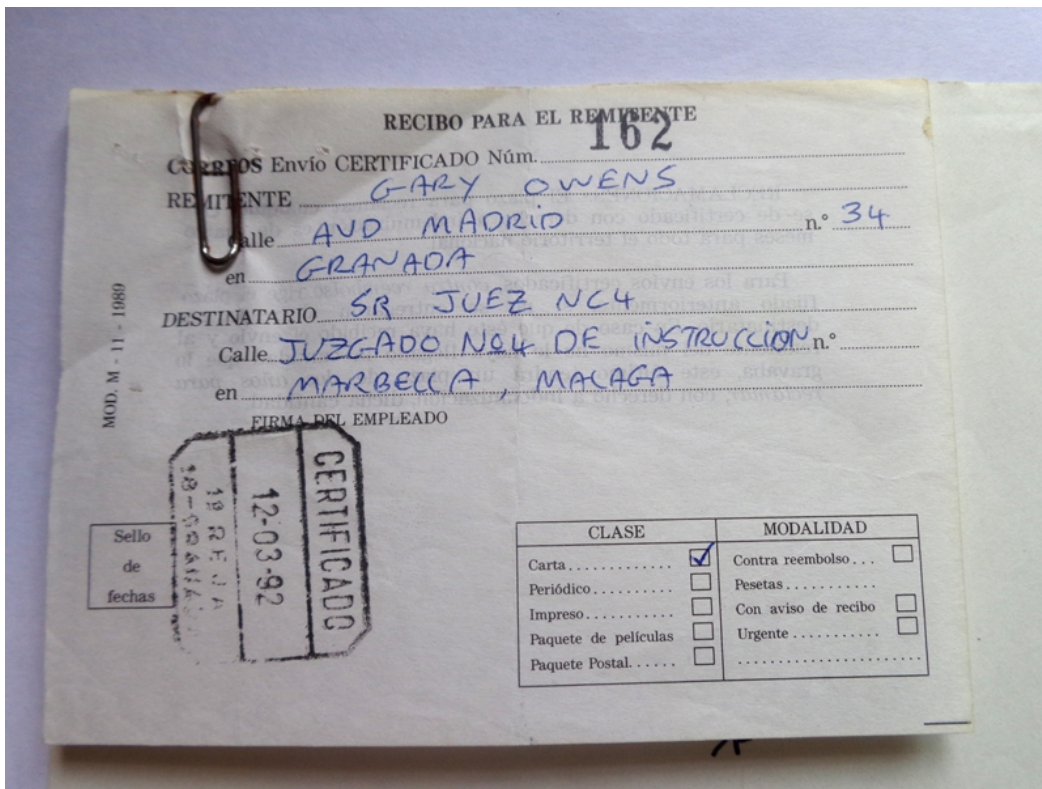
I have been in prison nearly one year now and would like to know why! I have been unable to raise sufficient money to pay a lawyer to represent me, this means I have little chance of a fair trial as spanish lawyers paid by the state don't do any work or that at least in my and my friends experience, I know things that can help prove my innocence, but no one writes back to me, it is my right to be able to defend myself, but your so called Justice system denies me this right.

I would like to know where my case is up to and would like to know who will be my lawyer so I can contact him/her, I don't want any lawyer previously allocated to me as they have done nothing, this is the fourth letter I have sent and I've had no reply, this letter is sent registered and copies are being sent to three British members of parliament, two European members of parliament and the under secretary of state for Britain as well as many newspapers, who are all taking an interest in my case and who are amazed that I have been in jail for one year and don't have a single piece of paper to say why. To say I was bitter towards your country would be a gross understatement, your system of Justice is incredible your country needs much more than a reform, it needs to shake off the old "Francs" image and wake up to a modern europe where there is Justice, but that is only a opinion mine!

For now it will be sufficient to tell me what is happening with my case and tell me who my lawyer is.

After receiving the first reply from the judge Dona Blanca Esther Diaz after many attempts to contact her, the letter appeared to say nothing.

I decided to talk to a prison guard, called Santiago at Granada prison who spoke English, he advised that he thought something was not right and the process did not seem normal, he said to write directly to the Fiscal in the case, and helped me translate the letter.

I sent the letter to the Fiscal on the 14<sup>th</sup> of April 1992 from Granada Prison.

I recently wrote to the courts in Marbella (copy of letter enclosed), They inform me to write to you.

I would like you to answer my questions on the letter to the court, Judge NC 4 Marbella.

I have been in prison over one year now, I have not committed a murder and don't know anything about the disappearance of the missing person in this case.

If any harm has come to the missing man then I'm sorry for him, but I have not had anything to do with it.

I have no money at all and can't defend myself. There is no chance of me having a fair trial, If I am to go to trial. Spanish state appointed lawyers do nothing to help, I have no way to prepare my defence. I know of evidence that can be gathered but the police and courts haven't answered my letters, The evidence I know of is vital to help prove my innocence, Why can't I get help or Justice here.

No one is interested in finding out the truth the court would answer my letters or want to talk to me if that was the case. I have heard or seen no one for one year! I have no papers to say why I'm here, One year is long enough to investigate any crime! There must be forensic evidence from the scene, I would like British forensic officers to examine the evidence and the statements. I have never had my statement read back to me in English, I was woken at 3am questioned for three hours and then sighed some papers, I have no idea what was written on them. I sent a separate statement to the court one year ago in English so did my girlfriend, (I have a copy), but it was never acknowledged by the court.

I would like copies of all statements made by me and anybody else in my case, so I can try to prepare a defence, I would also like access to all forensic evidence for test's to be done in Britain.

I can not trust my liberty to a state lawyer who has no interest in my case, Spanish lawyers and the system they work under do not posses the same ethics as British lawyers. It is impossible for a state paid lawyer to prepare a fair case for me, If I am to go to trial. If I could have provisional liberty I could prepare my case and you would see I have nothing to do with it.

Surely finding out the truth is what really counts, to leave me locked up with no lawyer. No charges and no chance to prepare a defence is inhumane and totally unjust.

I have a human right to be able to defend myself, Just because I have no money doesn't mean you can deny me this right and keep me locked up for years because I have no chance to prove my innocence. Please let me know what is happening with my case.

A la fiscalía de Málaga:

En un escrito que dirigí recientemente al juzgado de Marbella (cuya copia adjunto) me informaron que debía dirigirme a esta Fiscalía.

Desearía que me respondiera a ciertas cuestiones de mi carta al juez nº 4 de Marbella.

He estado en prisión durante más de un año. No he cometido ningún crimen ni sé nada acerca de la desaparición de la persona desaparecida en este caso. Si le ha sucedido algo a dicha persona, lo siento por ella, pero yo no tengo nada que ver con ello.

No tengo dinero alguno y no puedo defenderme. No hay oportunidad de que tenga un juicio justo si tengo que ir a juicio. Los abogados españoles que me han sido asignados no hacen nada por ayudarme. No tengo modo alguno de preparar mi defensa.

Conozco hechos que pueden ser vitales para ayudar a probar mi inocencia, pero ni la policía ni los juzgados han contestado a mis cartas. ¿por qué no puedo conseguir ayuda o justicia aquí?

Nadie está interesado en descubrir la verdad. El juzgado podría contestar mis cartas o hablar conmigo en todo caso. ;Ni he oído ni he visto a nadie durante un año!. No tengo papel alguno que diga por qué estoy aquí. Y un año es lo suficientemente largo como para investigar cualquier crimen.

Deben haber evidencias forenses en el escenario del crimen y me gustaría que forenses británicos las examinaran, además de las declaraciones. Nunca me ha sido leída mi declaración en inglés. Me tuvieron despierto hasta las tres de la madrugada y fui interrogado durante tres horas y entonces firmé algunos papeles. No tengo ni idea de lo que se escribió en ellos.

Envíé una declaración por separado al juzgado hace un año en inglés además de otra hecha por mi novia (de la que guardo una copia), pero nunca fue tenida en cuenta por el juzgado. Desearía copias de todas las declaraciones hechas por mí y cualquiera relacionado con mi caso, para que de este modo pueda intentar preparar una defensa. Desearía igualmente tener acceso a todas las evidencias forenses para que sean estudiadas en Gran Bretaña.

No puedo confiar mi libertad a una abogado de oficio que no tiene interés en mi caso. Los abogados españoles y el sistema bajo el que trabajan no poseen la misma ética que los abogados británicos. No es posible que un abogado de oficio prepare una defensa justa para mí si tengo que ir a juicio. Si pudiera conseguir la libertad provisional podría preparar mi caso y se vería que no tengo nada que ver con ello.

Encontrar la verdad es lo único que cuenta realmente.

Dejarme encerrado sin abogado, sin cargos y sin oportunidad alguna de preparar mi defensa es inhumano y totalmente injusto. Yo tengo el derecho humano de poder defenderme a mí mismo. Sólo porque yo no tengo dinero no quiere decir que me pueda ser negado este derecho y mantenerme encerrado años y años porque no tengo oportunidad de probar mi inocencia.

Por favor, permítame saber lo que sucede con mi caso.

in Reply to your letter dated 12-3-92 we can not answer your questions, you must write to the fiscal in Malaga, Explain why you dont want your state appointed lawyer, your reasons, and the name of the lawyer, if there is enough reason, for a change of lawyer we will change him and appoint you another one, or you chose one yourself, but he must be a lawyer who can practice in Malaga

CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THIS LETTER

i sent FOUR (4) letters to the count, TWO (2) to the Police, THREE (3) to the fiscal, ONE (1) to the college of lawyers, i gave up after that because i got no reply, only this reply from the count ever came back. one and a half years later (1½) the Judge in my case arrived at Malaga prison to see me because i was causing many problems to try and get attention to my unjust situation, i showed the Judge my letter (copy) and the letter i had received from the count, she immediately said she had never seen any of the documents, but admitted it was from her office. my lawyer then asked the Judge to sign pieces of paper to prove it wasnt her signature she did, her husband also did he is inspector of police for Marbella and is in charge of my case, he is also married to the Judge. his signature looked the same and my lawyer challenged him on it, he said it wasnt his, but what is more important is that the information is not correct and the count have no copy and no one admits to the signature, at the meeting with the Judge i disclosed a lot of information to the Judge, and at the end

of the meeting the Judge said it would be possible ③ to free me once they looked into it, they looked into it and have now given me bail but i have no money to pay. when i showed the Judge this letter she went outside the room with her husband to discuss it, the result of this court document is that it has meant i've spent one and a half years in prison when i would of had bail! i stated quite clearly in my letter to the court that i could prove my innocence with i have, i have been advised that this court document contravenes article 302 of the spanish penal code. i am seeking your advice on this matter.

the Judge said she was away having a baby at this time (when this court document was issued) so who was in court then sat in her chair with access to her stamp E.T.C. and why is there no copy and why hasent she seen or known about this. each court paper has a number, this must be checkable, because they are numbered in sequence and must be logged in a court book.

i believe that this letter was a deliberate and successful attempt to stop my evidence being heard, and to delay my case, for what motive i can only guess.

this court document has resulted in a grave miscarriage of justice against me and taken one and a half years of my life and i've been put through untold mental torcher because of it and so has my future wife. it has also stoped me from gathering important evidence.

This document is the Spanish law that relates to this fraudulent court document. This is part of the letter sent to Under secretary of state for Britain Mark Lennox Boyd on the 19<sup>th</sup> August 1993.

## CODIGO PENAL

### CAPITULO IV

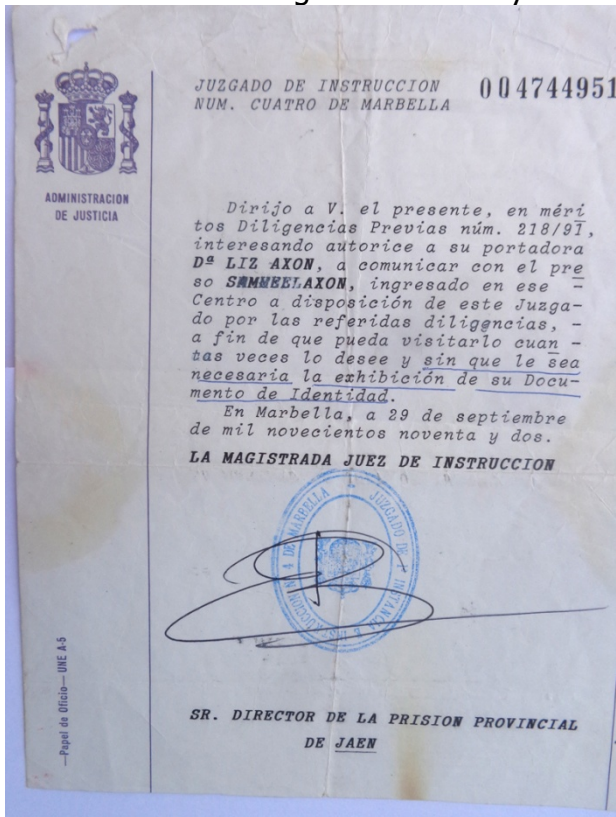

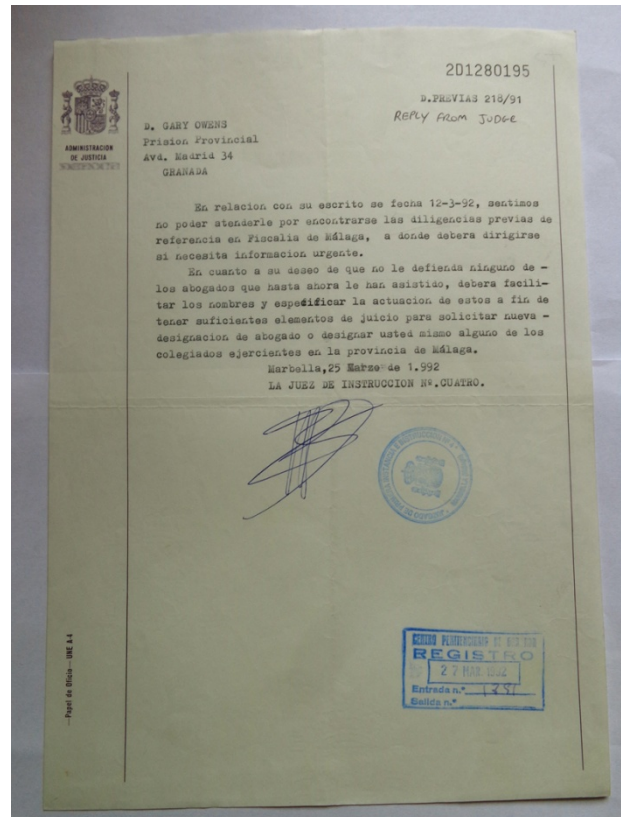

I had met with the Functionary from court number 4 marbella, Blanca Esther Diaz court, and he explained that they were breaking the law and falsely imprisoning me and trying to frame me so i could not speak out about the judges negligence. I decided to make a Denuncia to the ministry of justice about this whole corrupt process.

It took some time to find out what to do. I wrote to the UK government and a councillor who was related to me, look into it using the local MP and contacts that he had. He sent me a letter that started to explain why the judge did not want me to find out about her criminal negligence.

I received letters from various UK MPs, also from the Foreign Office in London who were now prepared to talk at government level in Madrid to the justice minister, i was told by Charles Formby of the Seville consulate that Mark Lennox Boyd was going to Madrid and would raise my case with the ministry, this happened.

I received this letter from Councillor Richard Fordham who was also Vice Chairman of the Humber Bridge a billion pound plus project and his words in the letter say it all, the case was corrupt from the start, the Marbella courts are corrupt, the whole justice system is corrupt.

Dear Charles,

I have been in touch with some council friends of mine in Spain, and discussed your case, I faxed the information to them and they say that your judge Dona Blanca Ester Diez has brought a supposed accusation against Jose Luis Manzanares, who is vice president of the "Consejo General del Poder Judicial", whom I understand make and review laws in Spain. I have been advised to speak to this man for an opinion on the legal conduct surrounding your case. As you know I had a British lawyer who is familiar with the Spanish legal system, look over your paper, and he says that there are several points that may be illegal and against your rights. He has advised me to get a second opinion from the vice president. Please inform me of your wishes, if you have not done so before 1st August 1993 I will proceed with my enquiries.

Elliot Morley M.P will have the foreign office contact the man, and the consulate will contact the court for copies of the papers. This man has apparently made allegations against the court too, and there are other people involved who I am trying to locate, it is felt that these people will be in a position to push your case.

If you have a copy of "Codigo Penal" please read article 302 which relates to the letter we have a copy of and the one from the court. Our legal legal advise says that this and three other articles could apply to your case, and are suggesting we ask for your immediate release following an investigation.

Keep your chin up son, we are fighting for you. You will win because you are innocent, we will not let corruption win, even if it means the government intervening on a national level.

Pat sends her love and we hope to see you very soon.

Gary Owens, interned in the Jaen II Penitentiary as a result of Proceedings Nr. of Instruction court Nr. 2 of Marbella, Malaga, held for the alleged crime of

holding British passport nr. , born in England, APPEARS and as proceeds according to law, DECLARES:

FIRSTLY: that he has been deprived of liberty for over two and a half years without having been notified of any decision or resolution according this deprivation.

SECONDLY: That on numerous occasions he has addressed official and personal letters to the magistrate of that Court, Doña Blanca Esther Diez García requesting information about his situation and developments in the proceedings, even invoking the rights conferred to himself by the Organic Law governing Judiciary Courts, without having received an answer from this Magistrate nor her Secretary, and having presented three different written applications requesting his freedom or a reduction in the amount of bail, all of which were also disregarded.

THIRDLY: that the aforesaid Magistrate did not see fit to hear this internee's account of the occurrences that resulted in the mentioned Proceedings, despite his having advised her repeatedly that he possessed confidential information regarding the facts and that his statement could contribute trustworthy details that would throw light on what occurred.

FOURTHLY: that he is likewise aware of the existence of certain judicial documents, apparently false but bearing stamps of the Court, in the falsification of which both the magistrate and her husband may be involved.

All of which is put before you to all legal effects and, if it be deemed to open an investigation, to contribute the documents that the declaring party has in his possession to illustrate what is here related.

As is due to justice, this is requested

As soon as the Judge found out i was going to have her imprisoned for her criminal offences the bail that i had already been given for 1 million pesetas was dropped to nothing and i was released. I was never involved in any way with the crime committed, I was not there and the judge proved that was the case at the first court hearing. This is pure corruption and criminal. I want to know what is going to be done about it!
